

Garden 2004 Competition



Overall champions from each year may continue to enter the competition in individual classes but will not be eligible for entry into the Championship Class for the following two years.

Winners of the New Tenants Garden Prize will not be eligible for entry into the Championship Class.

In the event of a draw, both persons shall qualify for the Championship Class where appropriate.

The judge's decision is final.

All trophies to be held for 12 months and to be returned to the Estate Office two weeks before the following year's prize giving.

Shields will be awarded to non prize-winning entries in all classes that, in the estimation of the judges, merit a highly commended award.

FURTHER DETAILS

Gardens are placed in several different classes:

Overall Champion - To be chosen from the winners of Classes I-VI, taking into consideration best use of space, plants, materials and ingenuity.

Class I - Balcony/window box/patio
- to include communal hallways.

Class II - Flats with gardens.

Class III - Houses and bungalows (retired persons).

Class IV - Houses and bungalows (others).

Class V - Last year's winners.

Class VI - All properties (this section will be for people with severe disabilities).

New Tenants' Gardens - A special prize may be awarded to a tenant who, in the estimation of the judge, has made substantial improvement to an overgrown and neglected garden within the first 18 months of the commencement of the tenancy. Entrants to be nominated by Trust staff.

Vegetables - At the judge's discretion, a merit award may be given for this group.

The George Award - To be given to the resident of the front garden which, in the judge's opinion, enhances the appearance of the Estate.

The Gordon Cherry Merit Award - This special prize will be given to the resident who has demonstrated creativity and interest in the hanging basket class.

Bloomin' Kids - For Children aged under 16 who have cultivated a piece of garden or planted an interesting pot.

Community Garden - For a scheme of residents who work together to achieve a communal theme.
