

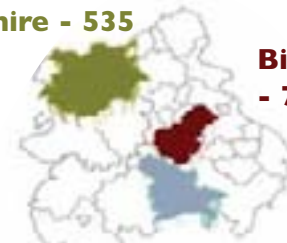

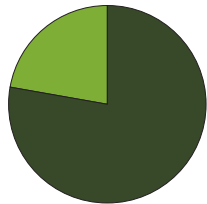
Performance Review 2006

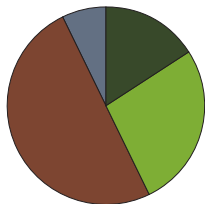
Birmingham

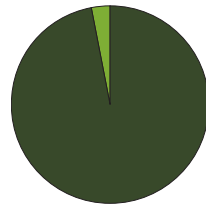


- Waiting List (Direct Applicants) **16%**

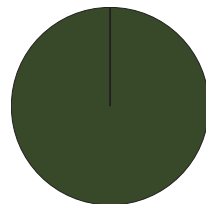

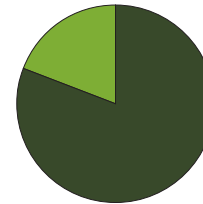

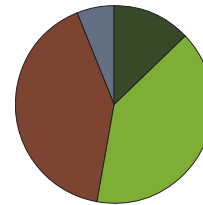
Birmingham & Shropshire

Bournville Almshouse Trust

Bournville Almshouse Trust provided three tenancies in 2006. Two of these were white and one was from a black or minority ethnic community. One was nominated from Birmingham City Council, whilst the other two were from the Trust's waiting list. All households were single people and none was previously homeless.
